New Bass Pro Shop CUP at the Harrisburg Mall

Scope:
Central Utility Plant including chillers, boilers, base-mounted pumps and all associated valves, louvers, fans, tanks, and heaters

Slated for demolition, renovations, and major upgrades, the Harrisburg Mall (owned and managed by St. John Properties) needed to have a separated Central Utility Plant (CUP) to serve the existing Bass Pro Shop site.

James CRAFT & Son was selected to perform the mechanical portion of the project, including:

- 2 Trane 200-ton air cooled chillers
- 3 Lochinvar 1000 btu gas-fired boilers
- 6 Taco base-mounted pumps
- 200 Feet of 4" and 8" below-grade double-walled Rovanko Pipe
- 500 feet of 4" and 8" above-grade pipe through the Bass Pro Shop store
- all associated valves, louvers, fans, tanks, and heaters

Among the challenges on this project was the scheduled shutdown of the mall's main boiler plant, and the tie-in to the new CUP for the Bass Pro Shop store.
